Main issues affecting your areas: Burglary and Vehicle Crime

PACT Priorities

The Norden PACT Priorities are as follows:

BURGLARY- (primarily occurring between Monday and Friday 11:00hrs to 20:00hrs. M.O is smashing rear premises window to gain access)

ASB- Recreational Ground (Hutchinson Road, evening time)

ASB- Greenbooth Road (various times)

GOOD NEWS

A 21 year old male was arrested and charged with burglary in the Norden area and theft from a vehicle in the Bamford area. The male was refused bail and taken to Magistrates court the on the next available date where he was remanded in custody to appear at Crown Court 29/03/19.

We cannot release the male's details as he is under investigation for other offences across the area.

KEY INFORMATION

GMP are implementing new online reporting methods and as of this week, the GMP website now allows for reports to be made online including:

- Crime Reporting
- Registration for Neighbourhood and Pub watch schemes
- Triage and advice services for Fraud and Missing Persons
- Reporting Counter Terrorism concerns

There is an option for reporting ASB but due to technical reasons this will not be functional until later this year. Hopefully the crime reporting function should alleviate the need to call 101.

Burglary

Spotland and Falinge area officers are investigating burglaries on their area where we have the evidence to do so and recently we have had some good quality CCTV from a burglary on Edenfield Road which we shared with the media. We have received a name for a suspect and enquiries are ongoing. Please can I remind everyone to ensure that the windows and doors are locked. When you are not at home use timers are on lights so it appears that someone is home and wherever possible utilise an alarm.

Method: There are no patterns to the methods used in these burglaries. Offenders in one of the burglaries have entered through an insecure front door whilst the victim has been at home. Please ensure your door is locked at all times, even if you are in your home it takes a matter of seconds for an offender to open your door, walk into your home and steal your property
